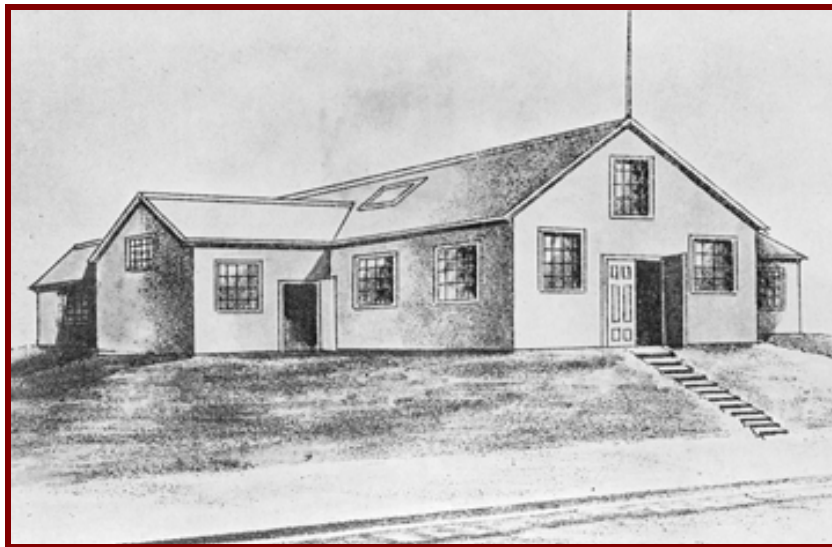

The first but temporary Melbourne Trades Hall was a four-roomed timber, iron roofed building. It was constructed on a grant of Crown Land at the corner of Victoria and Lygon Streets, Carlton and opened on the 24th May 1859. The permanent present day Trades Hall is situated on the same site. Its construction started in 1874 and took 50 years to complete in stages.
